and a big mountain,

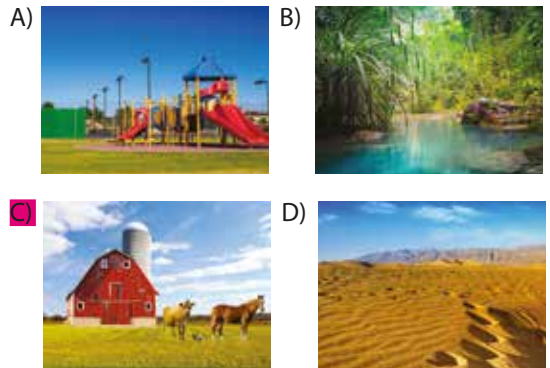
